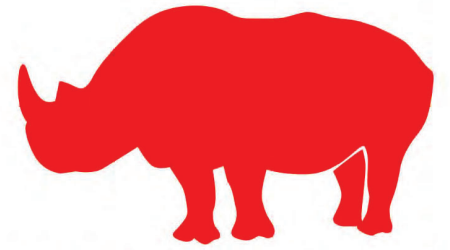


MISSION STATEMENT

- Founded in **1974** as a 501c3 Nonprofit
- Serves children in Pre-K through 12th grade
- Doesn't receive public funding or school vouchers
- Over **500** students have graduated from Harmony's high school
- Annual expense per student is **\$7,500** (1-12 grade)
- **80%** of all students receive a scholarship (**\$5,000** ave. amount)
- **45%** of Harmony students are economically disadvantaged
- Every class is Multi-Aged
- Classrooms incorporate student voice in decision making
